



Join the Baytown Historical Preservation Association's History Lecture Series

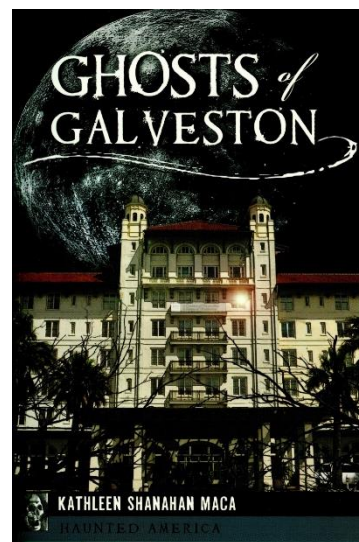
Guest Speaker Kathleen Shanahan Maca

Kathleen Shanahan Maca, a noted Galveston author and photographer, who has a love for old cemeteries, architecture, genealogy, and history will explore haunted tales from the Oleander City at the June 30 history lecture.

Kathleen, a Clear Lake-area resident, left the advertising industry after more than 20 years to focus on family and writing. A graduate of Sam Houston State University, she is a regular contributor to the *Galveston Monthly* magazine and a member of the Texas Chapter for the Association of Gravestone Studies. She also enjoys conducting group tours in Galveston cemeteries. A fan of ghost stories and legends since she was a child, she uses her experience in historical research and genealogy to add dimension to local folklore. In the process, she's found that non-fiction can be even stranger and more fascinating than fiction. Her books, *Galveston's Broadway Cemeteries* and *Ghosts of Galveston*, delve into largely unexplored aspects of Galveston history. She is currently working on a history of the Hotel Galvez, due out this coming fall.
