

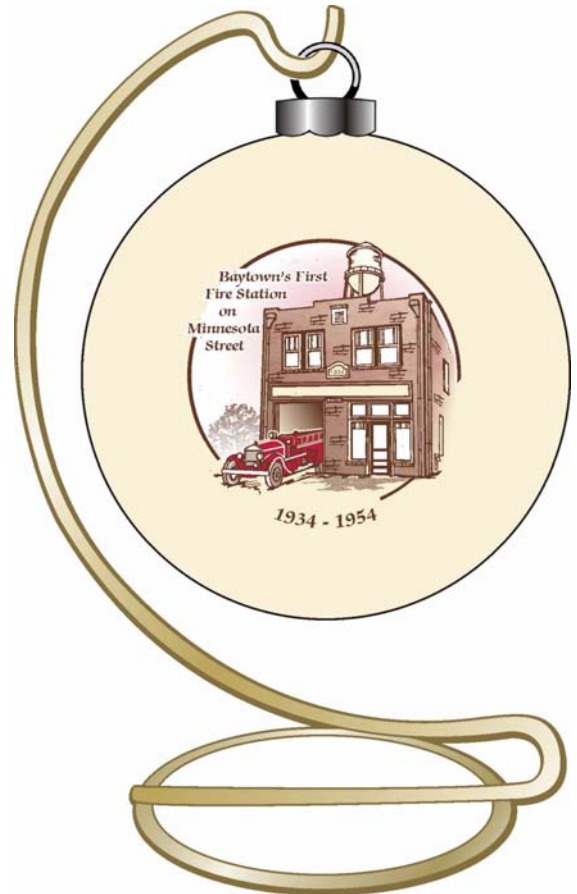
Reserve Your 2009 Limited Edition Tree Ornaments!
